National Curriculum Art and Design is a vital part of your child's education and involves exploring the properties of materials and their textures, experimenting with different effects, and having the freedom to create. Creativity is an important part of the national curriculum, as it encourages children to work independently.

A less obvious benefit of art learning is that it takes children to other worlds, cultures and times. Children explore ideas and meanings in the work of artists, craftspeople and designers and they learn about the diverse roles and functions of art, craft and design. Children learn more about how people lived in the past by looking at their art and artists. The Egyptians, for example, surrounded themselves with colourful buildings painted with scenes of everyday life and their gods. The paintings were meant to be realistic: in the tombs they represented the life which the deceased had led.

So there's a lot more to Art than just having fun with paint!



Please bring a <u>named water bottle</u> to school each day.

If your child has a <u>COVID symptom</u> of a cough, high temperature (above 37.8 degrees) or a loss of taste or smell they <u>must stay off school</u> and get tested for COVID19.
