Please ensure that you <u>distance</u> from other adults and families at drop off and pick up. <u>One</u> adult per child at drop off / pick up please. Once you have dropped off or collected your child please leave as quickly as possible. We need to avoid congestion at the gates and on the playground. Your cooperation with this is much appreciated. Face coverings MUST BE WORN at pick up / drop off please.

No unnecessary items including large school bags or pencil cases in school at this time please. Please ensure that your child on brings a SMALL bag on book return and issue days.

Pinehurst <u>PE Kit to be worn 1 allocated day per week</u>.

Please bring a <u>named water bottle</u> to school each day.

If your child has a <u>COVID symptom</u> of a cough, high temperature (above 37.8 degrees) or a loss of taste or smell they <u>must stay off school</u> and get tested for COVID19. The same applies to children if a household member has these symptoms. The whole household must self isolate and the children must stay off school.






Please do not drop litter outside school, please put it in the bin or take it home. Help us to keep our local environment clean and tidy.
