At Pinehurst we are introducing Thinking Moves an approach to Metacognition. Metacognition is 'awareness and understanding of one's own thought processes'. Alongside this, we are working on Self Regulation. This is 'self-management' i.e. the taking control of one's thinking (and feeling and acting).


We are adopting this approach to support the children in recognising the ways they are processing, evaluating and committing their learning to memory.

We have looked at different thinking skills and learnt moves to associate with them to help us apply them to our learning. Ask your child to teach you the moves for:

Thinking AHEAD and BACK, CONNECT and DIVIDE, EXPLAIN and FORMULATE
