OAA: Outdoor Adventurous Activities

As part of our PE curriculum, pupils in Key Stage 2 should take part in outdoor and adventurous activity challenges both individually and within a team. Therefore, it is planned for our Year 6 children to visit CHET later in the half term and focus on this aspect of the curriculum. They will be have opportunities to:

- Develop their understanding in a variety of land and water based adventurous activities
- Take part in problem solving or survival activities requiring pupils to plan collaboratively in pairs or small groups
 - Develop problem solving skills in a variety of situations in adventurous activities
 - Plan and work successfully as individuals, in pairs and in groups
 - Develop their understanding of the importance and significance of rules and safety
 - Develop their observation and evaluation skills which will involve:
 - o Working with others
 - o Asking questions of one another
 - o Listening to others
 - o Communicating with others
 - o Using key words 'word power'
 - o Co-operating with others
 - o Understanding roles and responsibilities
 - o Taking responsibility for their own learning
 - o Identifying strengths and weaknesses
 - o Setting goals and targets
 - o Employing different strategies to evaluate their own and others performances

IMPORTANT

Face coverings are advised at pick up / drop off please.

No unnecessary items including large school bags or pencil cases in school at this time please. Please ensure that your child on brings a SMALL bag on book return and issue days.

Pinehurst PE Kit to be worn 1 allocated day per week.

Please bring a named water bottle to school each day.

Alternate lunches of hot and cold options, children may bring a packed lunch if this is their preference.

Due to ventilation requirements, if your child is cold in school they should wear extra layers. This may include a vest or additional layer under their polo shirt, or a school or navy fleece over their sweatshirt. We will consider scarves and fingerless gloves as the term progresses and update you.

If your child has a COVID symptom of a cough, high temperature (above 37.8 degrees) or a loss of taste or smell they <u>must stay off school</u> and get tested for COVID19.

Once the test results are in, school must be informed. If it is during school hours please call the office 0151 263 1300, if it is outside school hours please call or text 07858 739336.
