Our RE teaching ensures that RE is responsive to the changing nature of schools and education. We aim to provide children the opportunity to develop, build and master their knowledge and understanding of their beliefs. They will show knowledge of previous learning and build and develop new skills and knowledge to show progression. We enable children to make links to their own lives and other beliefs.

We believe that it is important for all children to have access to opportunities for spiritual development and awareness and understanding of the great religious traditions.

In RE, pupils learn from religions and world views about different ways of life in local, national and global contexts. They discover, explore and consider many different answers to questions about human identity, meaning and value.

All children are given the opportunity to access the curriculum at their level and are provided with the resources required to enhance their understanding. They are given opportunities to discuss their ideas and beliefs.

Pupil Premium

If your child is eligible for free school meals, they may also be entitled to a sum of money paid to their school to boost their learning, this is called pupil premium. Although all Infant children receive a free school meal under a Government scheme it is still important that you register for Free School Meals so school can access this additional funding. This is also the case if your child is in any year group and choosing a packed lunch.

You may be eligible if you receive one of the following benefits:

Income Support.

Income Based Job Seekers Allowance.

Child Tax Credit Only (with income up to £16,190) with no element of Working Tax Credit.
