## Remote Learning Update

Our Remote Learning offer provides the curriculum that pupils are learning when they are in school and for those who need to be at home. We are all set up to work in this way until at least February Half Term. We realise that some of you may have difficulties with resources and we are keeping in contact with everyone to see if we can help - we are in this together. We also realise many of you are working from home with your children not able to come to school (as some of our staff are too). We are sympathetic to the problems and stresses this may cause – and again our team area here to help in any way that they can, please phone, email or text us. We have a duty of care to our staff and must limit the number of children we have on-site – frontline NHS and Education staff alongside vulnerable children have been prioritised and this has meant many people with challenging, demanding, important jobs are not able to have a place in school. We can only sympathise with you about how difficult this must be – but there are only a finite amount of places we can safely offer. We are so grateful for the parents who have made arrangements for their children and willingly 'given places up' so we can ensure that the parents, who need to be in a critical workforce, that will help us all ultimately manage at this difficult time, can be. As with the last lockdowns, as soon as we can take more pupils safely we will get back in touch and offer place. We cannot wait to have more of the Pinehurst Family back in school as soon as it is safe to do so.
