

The 8 'outstanding' or 'good' Liverpool primary schools that have been rated by Ofsted in 2022
These schools received the top OFSTED rankings in 2022.

Liverpool boasts a number of brilliant schools, and we have compiled a list of those that have received the highest OFSTED rankings, of 'good' and 'outstanding', this year.

OFSTED is the regulatory body responsible for visiting schools across the country and grading them on a fourpoint scale.

At the bottom of the scale is 'inadequate', followed by 'requires improvement', 'good' and 'outstanding'.

Grades are based on overall effectiveness, quality of education, behaviours and attitudes, personal development, and leadership and management.

Take a look to see which local primary schools were ranked 'good' or 'outstanding' in 2022.

4. Pinehurst Primary School - Good
Pinehurst Primary School Anfield was rated 'good' in
May 2022. The report published by Ofsted reads: "Pupils
have opportunities to develop their leadership skills
through roles as school councillors, reading ambassadors
or as rainbow buddies who support new pupils to settle
into school. Pupils also visit places of interest in order to
support their learning and to celebrate their local
heritage."
