Once you have dropped off or collected your child please <u>leave as quickly as possible</u>. We need to avoid congestion at the gates and on the playground. <u>No unnecessary items</u> including large school bags or pencil cases in school at this time please. Please ensure that your child on brings a SMALL bag on book return and issue days.

Please bring a <u>named water bottle</u> to school each day.

If your child has a <u>COVID symptom</u> of a cough, high temperature (above 37.8 degrees) or a loss of taste or smell they <u>must stay off school</u> and get tested for COVID19. The same applies to children <u>if a household</u> <u>member has these symptoms</u>. The whole household must self isolate and the children must stay off school.

Once the test results are in, <u>school must be informed IMMEDIATELY</u>. If it is during school hours please call the office 0151 263 1300, if it is outside school hours please call or text 07858 739336.

In the event of a school bubble having to isolate notification will be by text, tweet and letters will be published on our website. <u>Please ensure that you</u> <u>check your phone for such messages</u>.

All children should be collected at their allocated time please. Collecting siblings early is impacting on missed learning time. Thank you for your cooperation.

DISCORD is an App that lets people chat via text, voice or video in realtime. It is very popular with gamers
