





## Teaching and Learning





At Pinehurst we use Maths No Problem to support our teaching of Maths. Ask your child to share with you what they have been learning in Maths this week.





## Pupil Premium

If your child is eligible for free school meals, they may also be entitled to a sum of money paid to their school to boost their learning, this is called pupil premium. Although all Infant children receive a free school meal under a Government scheme it is still important that you register for Free School Meals so school can access this additional funding. This is also the case if your child is in any year group and choosing a packed lunch.

You are eligible if your family income is under £7400 (net) per year. If you may be eligible please visit the school office in confidence.
