Our website is an important way of keeping our #PinehurstFamily up to date and involved in school life.



Pupil Premium

If your child is eligible for free school meals, they may also be entitled to a sum of money paid to their school to boost their learning, this is called pupil premium. 



The Importance of Good Punctuality

Arriving at school on time sets the tone for the whole day.

Gates open at 8.40am, giving plenty of time for pupils to settle in before registration at 8.50am. Lessons begin immediately afterwards, so being late means missing valuable learning right from the start

. The first lesson of the day is especially important it sets the pace, introduces key concepts, and helps children feel ready and focused.

By ensuring your child arrives on time every day, you give them the best possible start and avoid the disruption caused by late arrivals.


